## The 14th annual Westcoast Motorcycle Ride to Live in-person event is back on May 28th, 2023 in Langley.

Virtually the event runs until September 6th.

This is a time to celebrate survivors, families, loved ones and remember those we've lost.

### Langley

We are revamping the ride for 2023. No longer will we travel from destination to destination to receive a poker punch, but instead create an adventure at each stop. The event is limited to 200 riders who will each head to four different destination, but will all end at the same location. Here the festivities include live music, lunch and top awards (top fundraiser, top team & top poker hands) as a way to kick off the beginning of the riding season.



### **Virtually**

The virtual event has participants partake in a self guided ride to gather photos for their poker stops. These are then transferred onto the an interactive map celebrating the remarkable awareness campaign.
